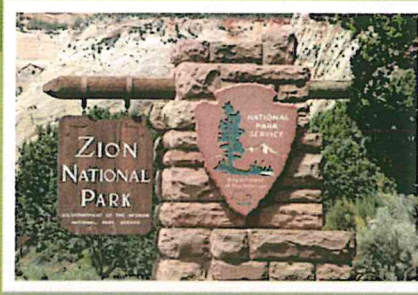

Zion-Mt. Carmel Tunnel

Did you know the Zion-Mt. Carmel Tunnel is 1.1 miles long? Construction began in the late 1920's. The tunnel was dedicated on July 4, 1930 and was the longest tunnel of its type in the United States. In 1958 a sand pillar collapsed depositing much debris in the tunnel causing it to close for weeks. Much reinforcement has been done over the years, and the tunnel is now electronically monitored 24 hours a day to warn park officials of possible dangerous situations.
